

B9 Support Intersex youth

Summary

This motion calls for us to specifically mention the issues facing intersex youth when campaigning for the wider community.

1 Notes:

- 2 • Intersex people are people born with difference in genitalia, chromosomes,
3 gonads, internal sex organs, hormone production, hormone response and/or
4 secondary sex traits
- 5 • Intersex people face similar fear, bias that faces members of the
6 LGBTIQ+ community
- 7 • Intersex youth are often undergo non-consensual surgeries which are in not
8 medically necessary
- 9 • As these surgeries are performed on intersex youth as infants this denies
10 them bodily autonomy and leave them with reproductive issues, issues with
11 sexual function and problems with emotional well-being
- 12 • We must campaign to remove stigma and medicalisation of intersex bodies,
13 use intersex inclusive language, legislation reform that include intersex
14 people and speak out against injustice

15 Believes:

- 16 • Intersex youth are an often overlooked group that face discrimination
- 17 • Laws that negatively affect trans and non-binary people also negatively
18 affect intersex people
- 19 • Intersex people face similar struggles to the LGBTQ+ community and
20 should be accepted as part of the community

21 Resolves:

- 22 • To advocate for intersex youth just as much as trans and non-binary people
