Delete from line 91 to 93:

B3.7.5 Amendments may not substantially change the intention of the paper ~~and nor may they require changes to another section of the Constitution or Standing Orders.~~

Reason

Sometimes, an amendment can be perfectly valid in achieving the purpose of the original amendment, but simply requires a change to another part of the ruling documents, for example, another area where the main topic of the original substantive amendment is referenced.
